Beyond Citations: From academia to the workplace

Diversity and inclusion practitioners and academics who conduct research on issues of diversity often share a common goal: to make meaningful social impacts and to effect change within their communities.

However, on-the-ground practitioners are often strapped for time to reflect on and engage in theoretical conversations surrounding the themes of

diversity and inclusion. They also sometimes lack resources to draw on for empirical evidence. At the same time, researchers and academics face obstacles when trying to broaden the reach of their fieldwork and thus struggle to make their work useful for others.

To address this gap, CCDI has launched Beyond Citations, to help graduate students mobilize their work in meaningful way and help diversity practitioners access the latest research in the field. Read more...
